



Scanlon Creek Bird Banding Workshops

Back by popular demand, three bird banding workshops will take place in February at the Nature Centre, Scanlon Creek Conservation Area. Nigel Shaw, renowned nature artist and expert bird bander will be leading the workshops. **The dates are Sunday, February 5; Sunday, February 12 and Monday, February 20 all starting at 8:00 a.m. until noon.**

Nigel will begin the workshop indoors at the Nature Centre with a power point presentation and following will be a discussion period. At 9:00 a.m., the group will go outdoors and watch Nigel retrieve the birds for banding. If the weather is too cold, Nigel can do the bird banding indoors. The ones to be banded will be the small winter feeder birds: chickadees, winter finches, maybe some woodpeckers. After the bird banding, Nigel will lead the group on a walk-about around Scanlon Creek.

The cost is \$15.00 per person and \$50.00 for a family of four per workshop. Each workshop has a 20 person limit. To register, please call Judy Milner at 905-895-1281 ext. 241.
